We are a B-BBEE Level 1 Contributor: 135% Procurement recognized organisation.

The initiation of the foundation was with the purpose and passion of helping young people in developing areas, but as the organisation grew, we saw the need to accommodate every young individuals who are in need - globally, who are clueless about the strategies of life, careers, education, talents and skills, to develop the greatest mindsets, to positively influence, change, empower, guide, support, teach, motivate, inspire and mentor more youth in a form of youth development and mentorship.
